BE BAPTIZED (MATTHEW 28:19-20)

PURSUE

Spend time daily reading the Bible (2 Timothy 3:16-17), praying (Jeremiah 33:3), walking in obedience (James 1:22), and loving and serving others (John 13:34-35).

TELL

Begin telling others what Jesus did in your life right now! Help them know Jesus and live for Him! (Matthew 28:19-20)

(1) WHAT IS THE GOSPEL?

ONE GREAT GOD

God has many attributes. God is the creator. God is loving. God is most importantly holy and just.

*Know that the Lord is God. It is He who made us, and we are His.
Psalm 100:3*

*For it is written: "Be holy, because I am holy."
1 Peter 1:16*

ONE GREAT PROBLEM

Our sin (breaking God's commandments) separates us from God. Our sin creates a great canyon between God and us because our sin is opposed to God's holiness. This gap is far too deep and wide for us to cross ourselves. Our good deeds will not make us right with God. Because God is holy and just, He must judge sin. Hell was created to justly punish sin wherever it is found.

*For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.

*All of us have become like one who is unclean, and all our righteous acts are like filthy rags...

*For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord

ONE GREAT HOPE

Because of God's great love for us, He sent His Son into the world to live a perfect life and show us how to find hope. He became the sacrifice we needed by dying a horrible death, in our place, on the cross to pay for our sins. So even though we broke God's law, Jesus paid our penalty so we can be pardoned. He then proved all He said was true by rising from the dead, which gives us assurance of life after the grave and an abundant life on earth!
